Tour Summary:

Gardenista is a festival celebrating the rich diversity of Comboyne's creative landscape. Centred around the Comboyne War Memorial Hall, it includes demonstrations of botanical art and couture, as well as the famous garden walks in beautiful private gardens spread across the plateau

Visit:

- Comboyne Village Lenore Dixon's Garden, Comboyne Community Centre & Comboyne Memorial Hall
- Hill Street Gardner's Rainforest Garden, Anderson's Garden. Comboyne Rural Fire Service (sausage sizzle) & Allan Litmore's fascinating Tractor Museum
- Windrush Garden (features an historic garden of mature trees, formal rose garden, and extensive plantings of cool climate shrubs and flowers) Spit roast BBQ lunch, gin, wine, and beer tasting, music.
- Waterfall Garden (set on a dramatic hillside avocado farm. Extensive vistas add to the charm and splendour of this beautiful garden)— tea, coffee and freshly made scones at Sundowner Cottage. Plant stall and native bee exhibition.
- O'Sullivan's Lane entrance to Tranquillity Garden (huge eucalyptus under planted with a variety of azaleas. Sweeping views over the Byabarra valley towards Bago Bluff and the coast. Includes formal hedged garden with arbours of beautifully perfumed stephanotis.) and Mistover Gardens (Set over 2 acres alongside a beautiful lake and waterfall. Many sculptures set amongst the garden add a delightful element of whimsy. A stunning Sculpture Walk sits on the lakeshore. A fairy garden will enchant the young at heart).
- Comboyne Museum
