

# Krambach Cup Day

*with Port Bus to Manning Valley Race Club*

**Friday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021**



## ***Tour Summary:***

The Krambach Race Club was formed in 1882 and conducted race meetings at "Larry's Flat" on the outskirts of the Krambach Township which was owned by the Paterson family. Racing first started with Picnic Christmas meetings but by the turn of the Century (1900) it had grown in a big way. One of the early races of fame was a match race between **Bucca Wauka** and **Charcoal** owned by neighbours Tom Paterson and Robert Roy. Victory went to Bucca Wauka for owner Paterson, ridden by his brother in law Stephen Lynch. During the 1930's depression years the racing really slumped with a meeting only attracting 4 runners for the three race programme, the main race was won by **Mystery** defeating **Honour**. During World War 11 meetings were conducted in aid of the Red Cross and on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 1945 the Club conducted their first meeting under AJC Rules. In 1968 the Krambach Club began racing at the Taree Racecourse at the request of the AJC. In 1974 the Bushland Drive Racecourse at Taree was officially opened with Krambach conducting the first meeting.
