Urunga Boardwalk

The Urunga boardwalk was built in 1988 and is some 2 KM long out to the ocean beach. Rugged rock breakwater lines the edges to the sea next to the boardwalk. Enjoy a cuppa at the Boardwalk café.

Urunga Wetlands Walk

Urunga Wetlands walks is a lovely, quiet place with good bird watching and photographic opportunities. The trail has interesting signs about the Broken Hill Antinomy Pty Ltd plant that processed ore from the antimony mine at Wild Cattle Creek



in the early 1970s. Significant environmental damage was done. The trail is accessible – flat with a hard surface and boardwalk. There is parking but no other facilities. This is a short but rewarding walk, combine it with Urunga Boardwalk if you have more time.
