It was established in 1867 after the Sydney colony outgrew its previous two cemeteries at the site of the current Sydney Town Hall and near Central Station. Learn about Rookwood's fascinating history, the story behind its development and evolution, and its significant link to our nation's heritage – by attending one of our [histories](#) talks or tours. The History Tours include a guided tour throughout Rookwood's most historic and captivating areas, from its vast landscape and culturally specific gardens, through to its heritage buildings and memorials.

**The Hunter Region Botanic Gardens** cover an area of more than 130

hectares, much of which has been preserved as natural bushland. The Gardens are
