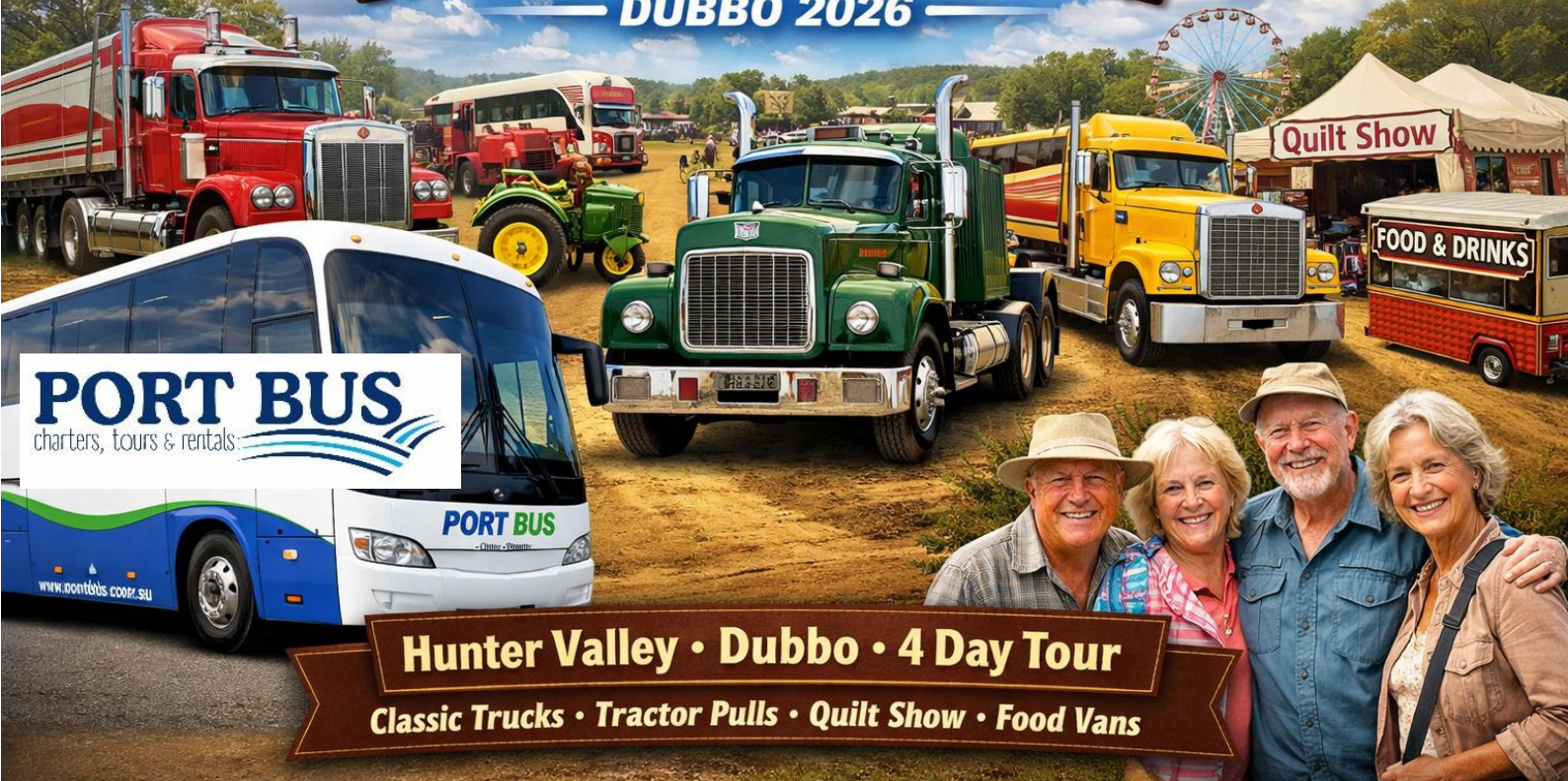


# Golden Oldies Truck Show Tour

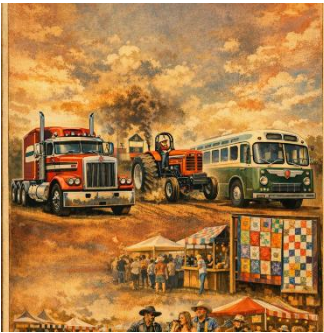
