From Craig Ilott and Stuart Couzens (GATSBY at The Green Light, L'Hôtel) and director Neil Dorward (Circus 1903, The Illusionists), Hook's Neverland is a thrilling new live show featuring an outstanding international cast of acrobats, aerialists and illusionists. Embarking on a treacherous adventure of mischief and possibility, they'll have you questioning the fairytale and the so-called villain you thought you knew.

Come aboard this dazzling celebration of imagination, family and the child within us all.

Itinerary:

Day 1:

Departing Port Bus at approximately 7:15am (time TBC), we begin our journey south with a comfort stop in Bulahdelah along the way.

Continuing on to the Central Coast, we stop at Westfield Tuggerah where there will be time to purchase lunch, browse the shops and stretch the legs before continuing into Sydney.

We expect to arrive at the Great Southern Hotel at around 2:30pm. Once checked in, there is time to settle into your room, enjoy a short walk nearby or perhaps relax with a beverage at the bar before our early dinner at 3:45pm.

Day 1 continued:

At approximately 4:45pm, we board the coach and make our way to the magnificent Sydney Opera House for our 6:00pm performance.

Settle into your seat and enjoy the show, which runs for approximately 80 minutes with no interval. Following the performance, we regroup and return to the hotel for a well-earned rest after a wonderful first day in Sydney.

Day 2:

After enjoying a **hot plated breakfast** at the hotel, we check out and climb back aboard the coach to begin our journey home along the familiar **Yellow Brick Road North**.

We'll make a comfort stop along the way before continuing to **The Nabiac Hotel**, where we will stop for lunch and the chance to enjoy a relaxing beverage before the final leg of our journey.

After lunch, we continue north with passenger drop-offs expected to commence from around **3:00pm**, bringing our Sydney theatre getaway to an end.
